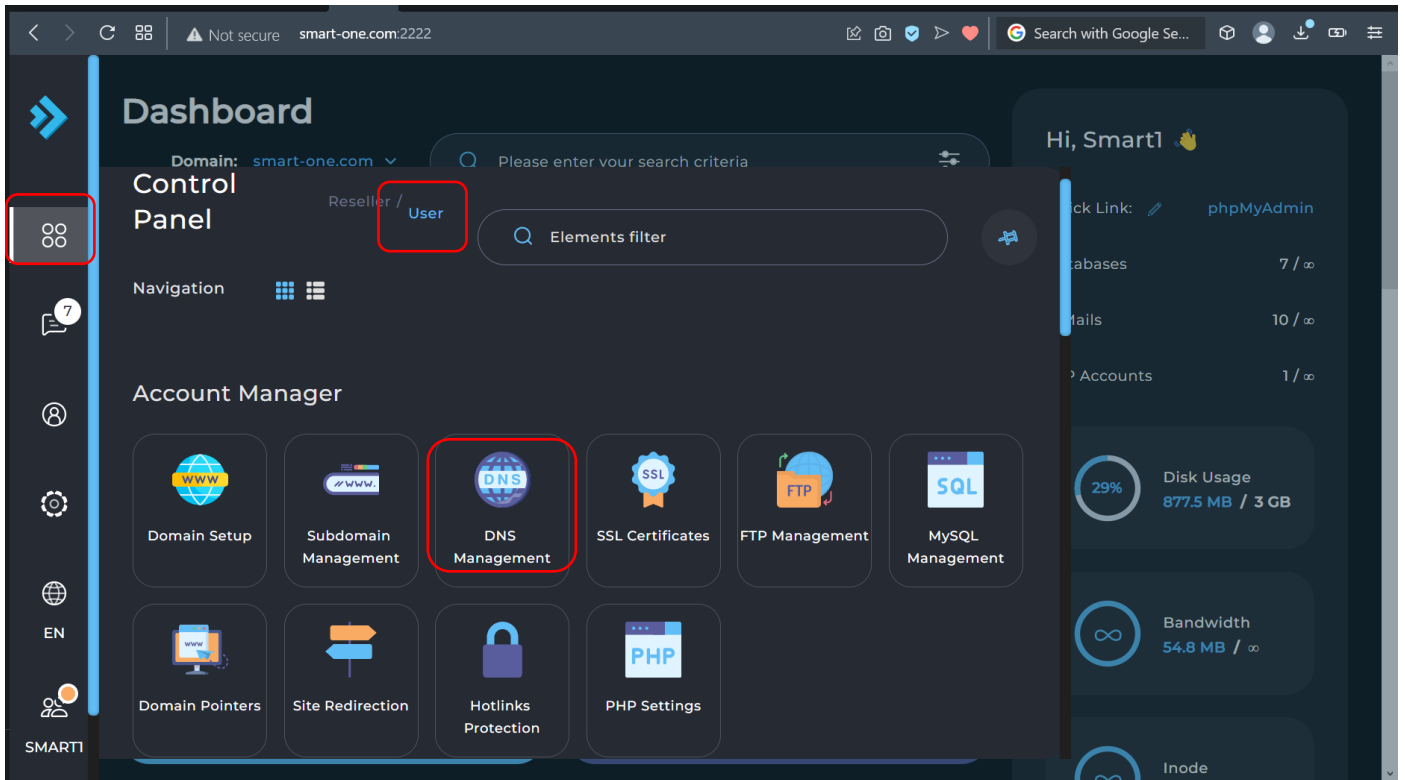


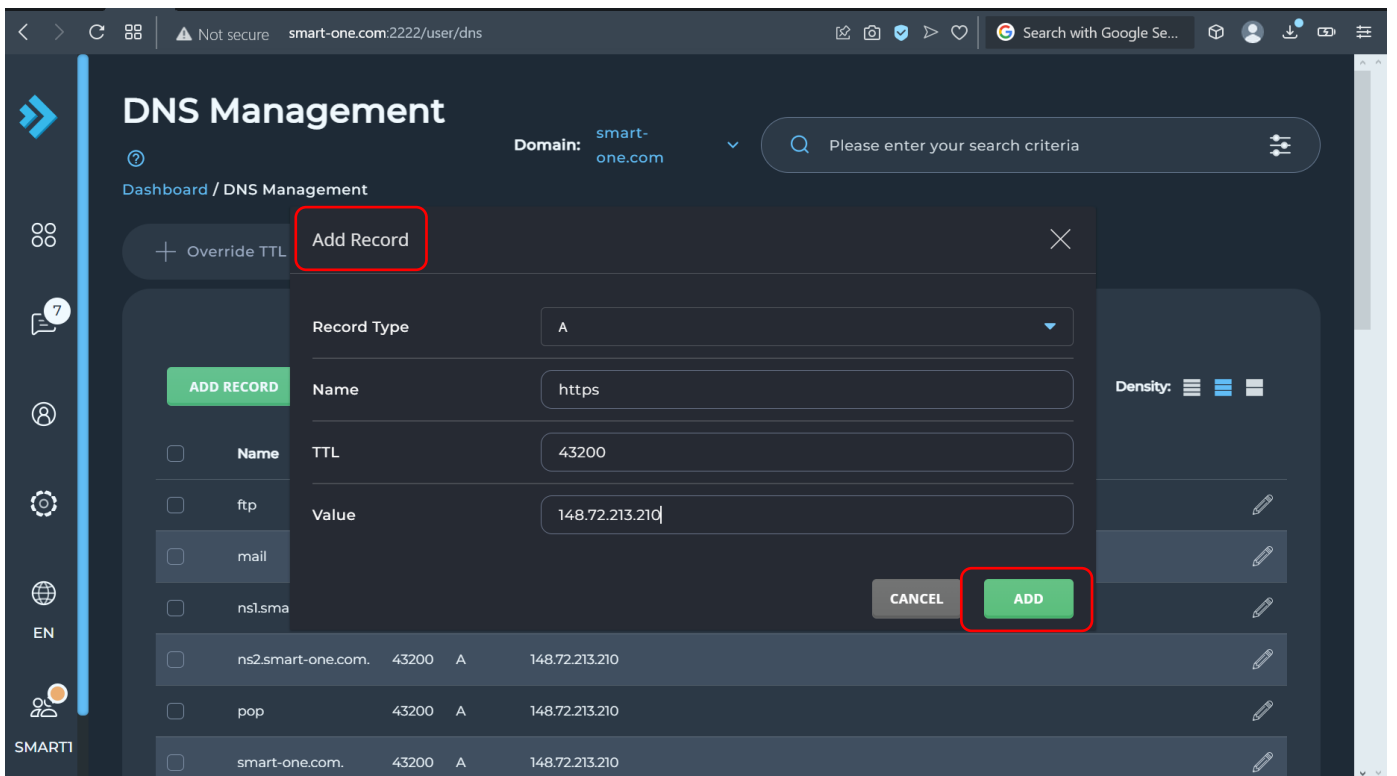
How to enable SSL Certification and installation on DirectAdmin for a Domain

A: add DNS record

1, Login to DA control panel user mode.



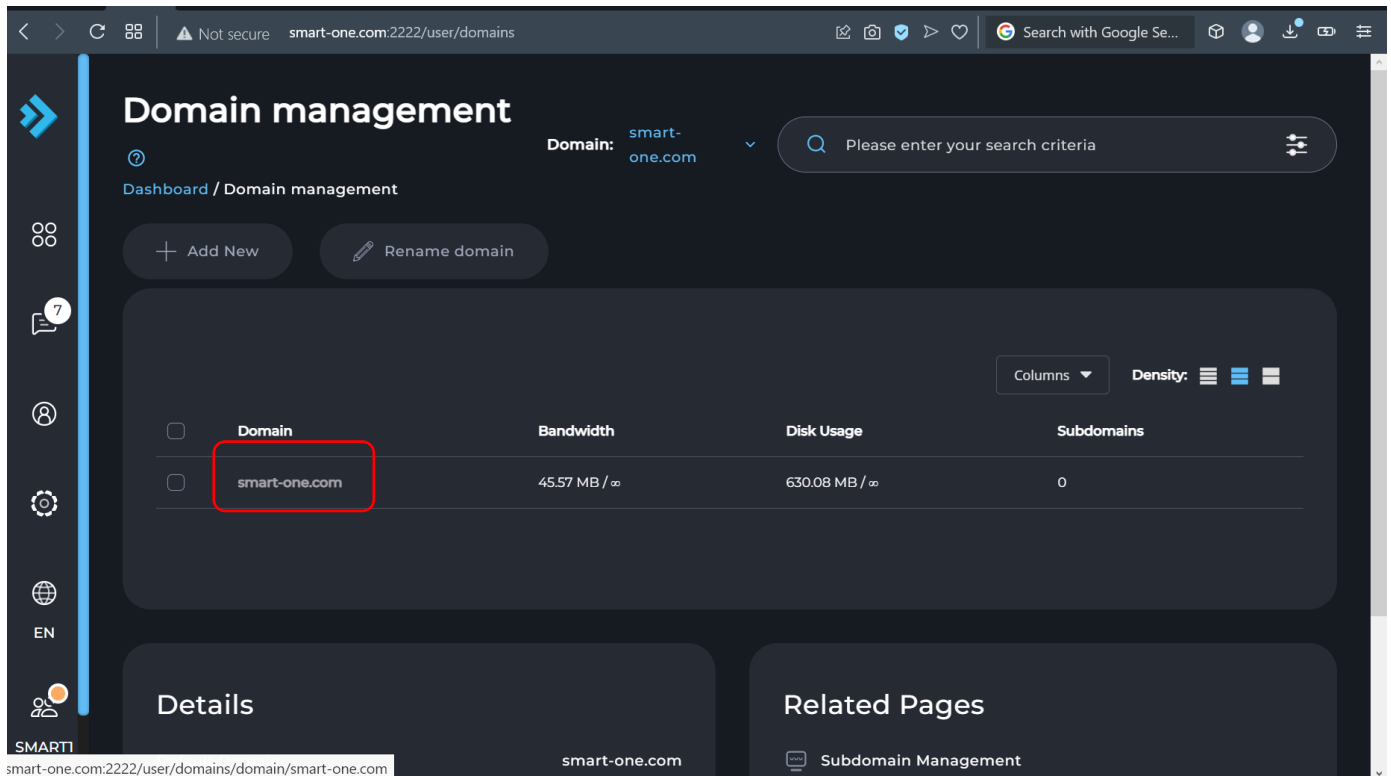
2, Click on "DNS Management" on Dashboard.



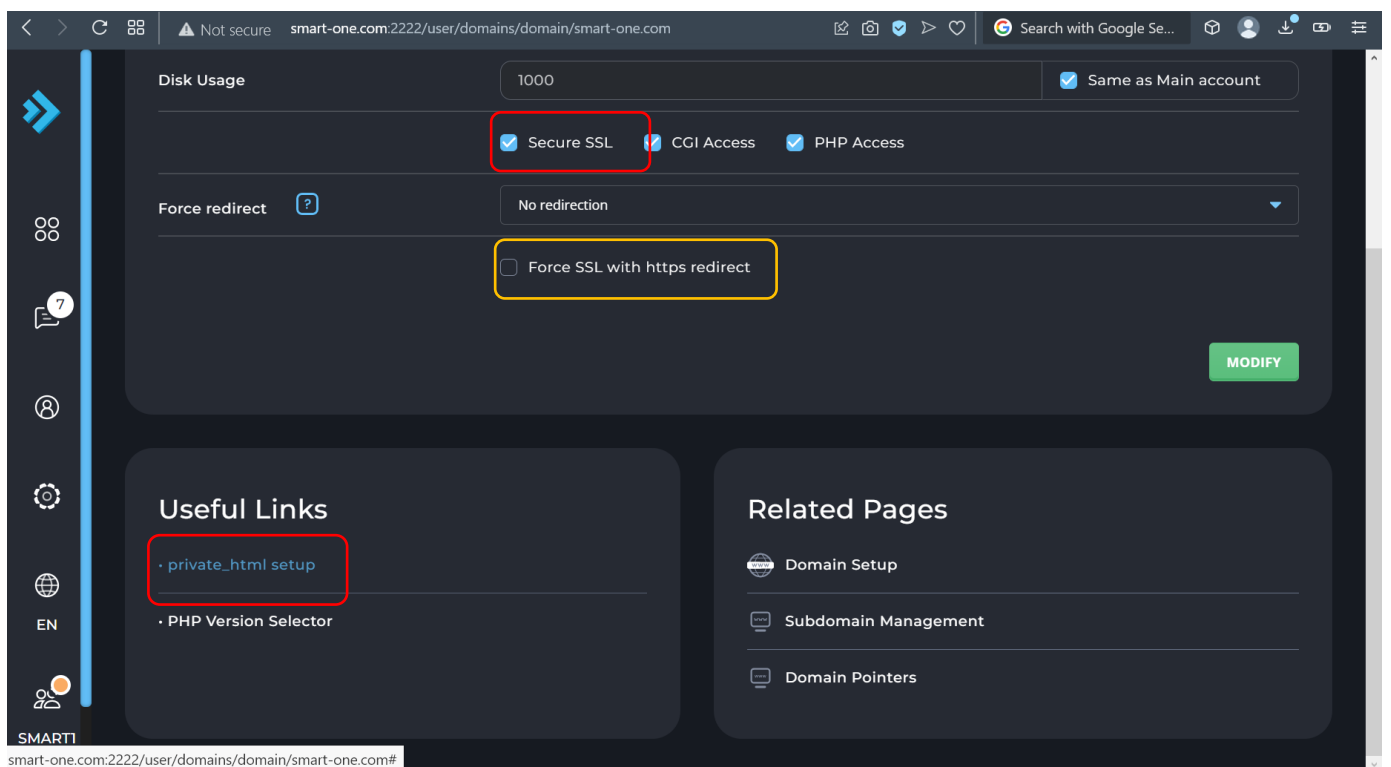
3, Click "Add Record" on DNS Management page.

4, Add "A" record with name "https", TTL "43200", Value "148.72.213.210" (Server IP address).

B: Enable “Secure SSL” and redirect “public_html” to “private_html” by create a “a symbolic link”



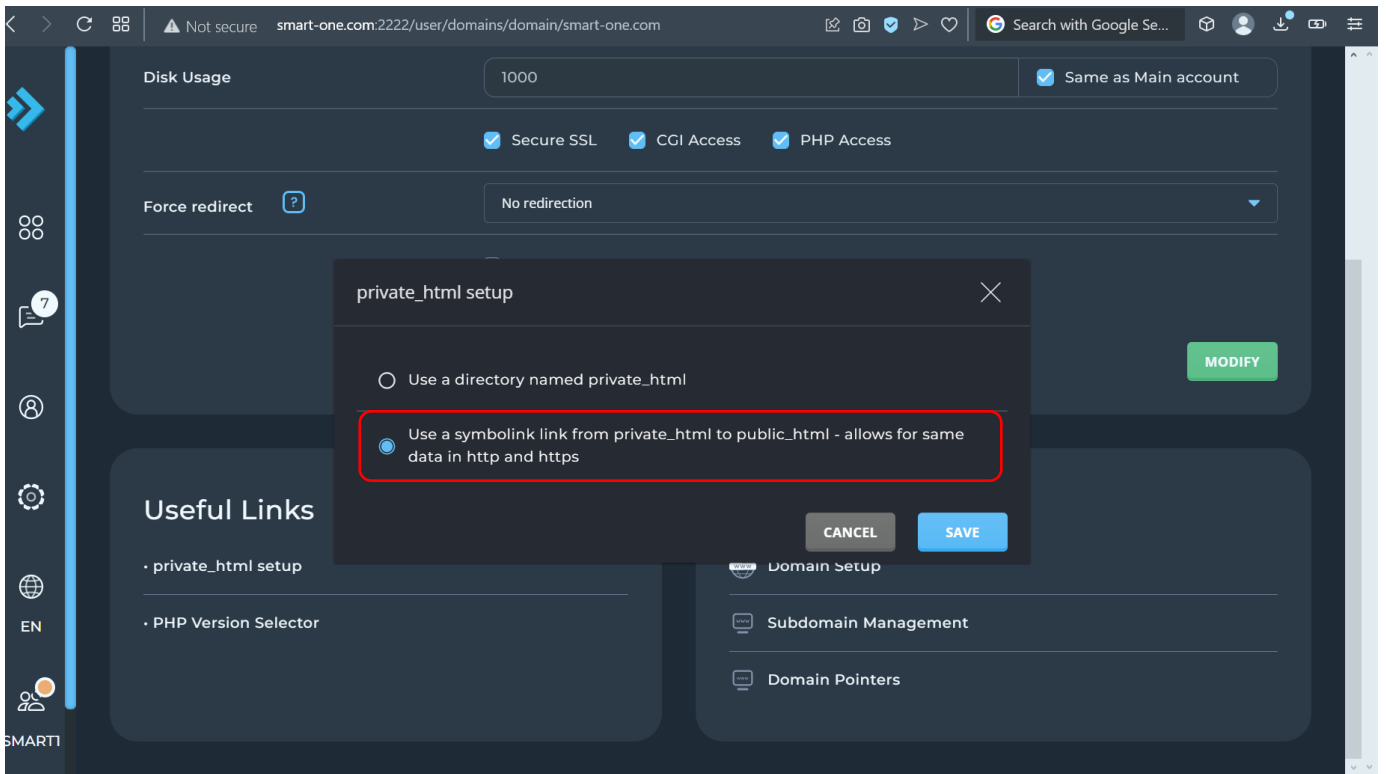
5, Click on your domain on “Domain Management” page.



6, Make sure “Secure SSL” is enabled for selected domain.

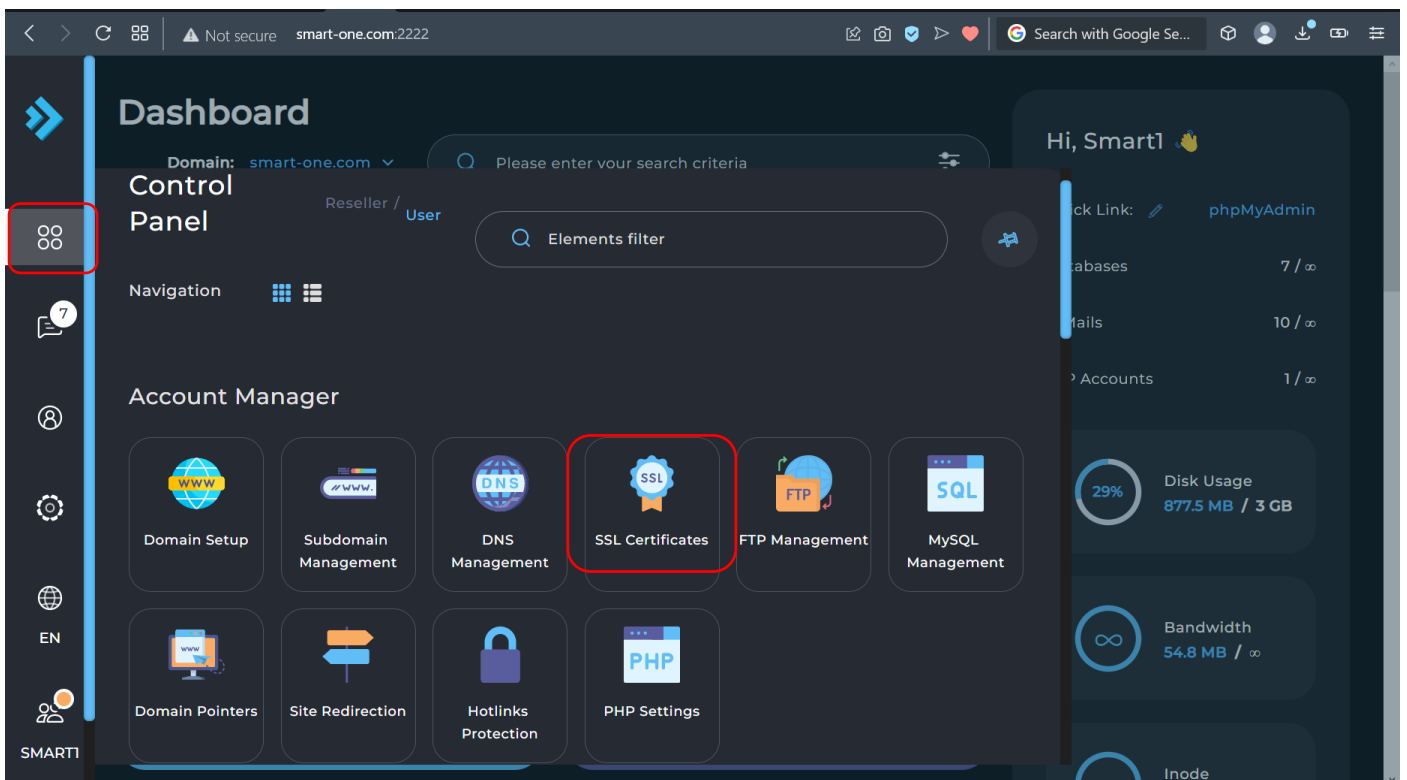
6a, “Force SSL with https redirect” is recommend, This enables HTTPS redirect for your website so that your visitors are automatically redirected to the secure version of the website.

7, Click “private_html setup” on above page.

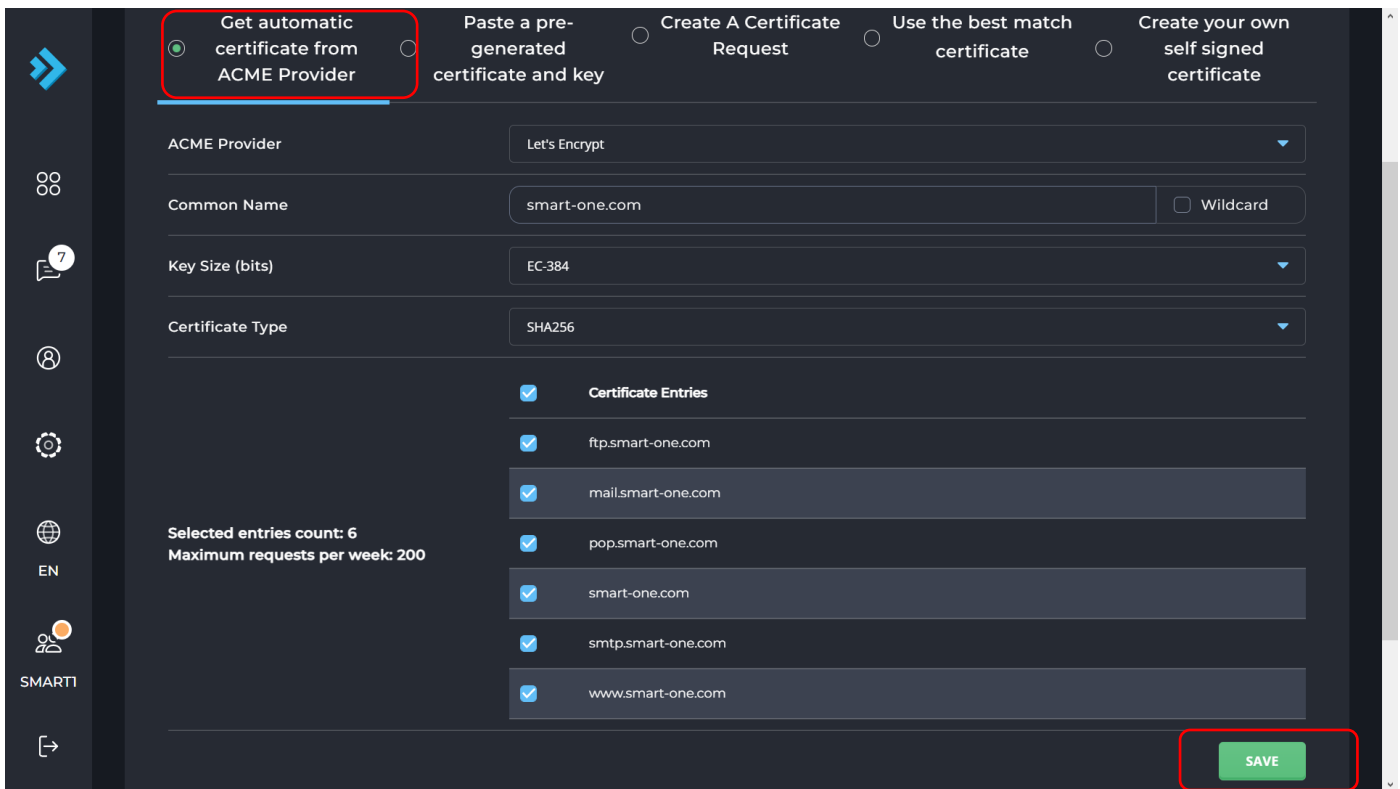


8, Select “Use a symbolink link ...” and save it.

C: Install SSL Certification

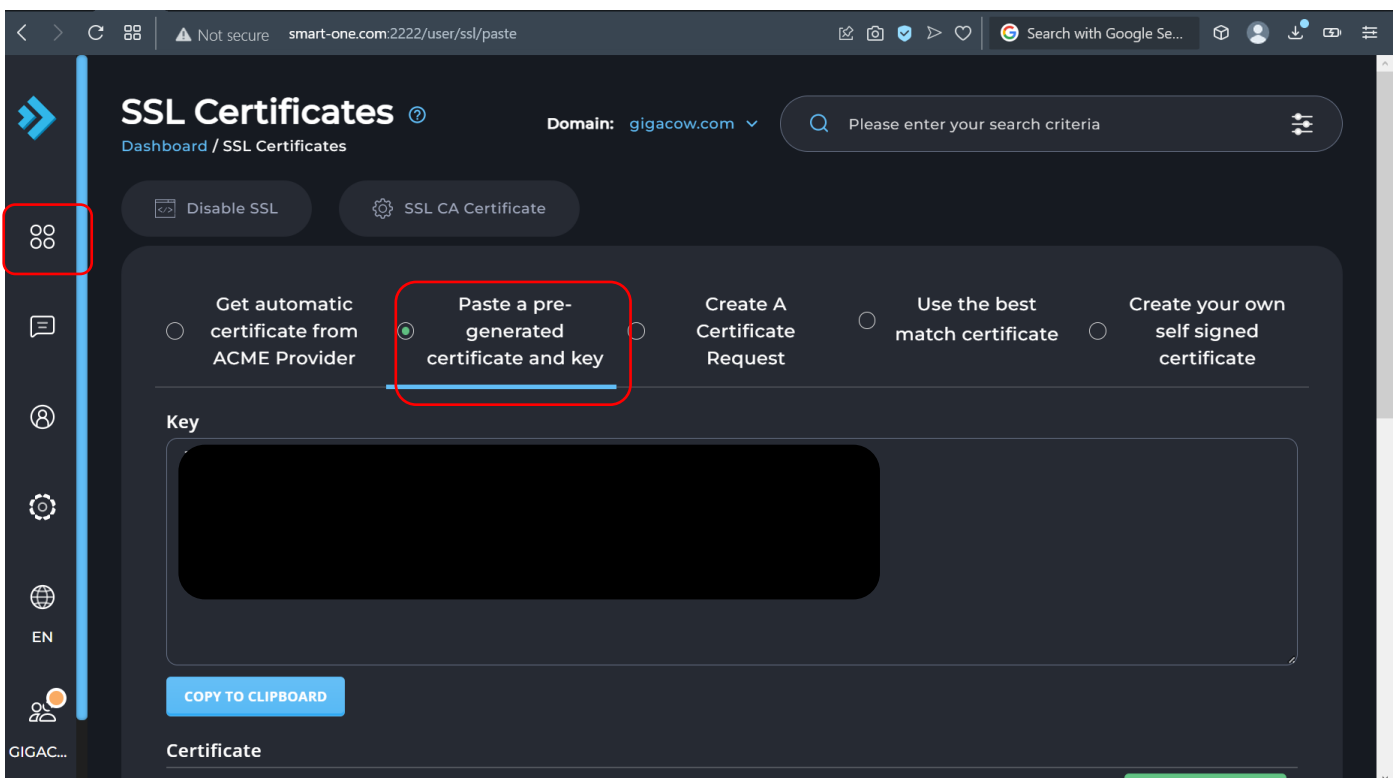


9, Click on “SSL Certifications” on Dashboard.



10, Enable "Force SSL with https redirect" at bottom of above page and save it.

11, Select items on above page and click "Save"



12 Click "Save" at bottom on above screen to save certification and key to DA.
